REGARDING: REQUEST TO APPLY FOR WYOMING 2023 STATE HOMELAND  
SECURITY GRANT

JUSTIFICATION:

The Campbell County Sheriff's Office is seeking permission to apply for the Wyoming 2023 State Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$34,461.60 for the purchase of a portable digital x-ray processor, the ScanX Scout D5000-SB (WMDTech KIT) and additional imaging plates and holders.

This equipment will replace our current digital x-ray processor, while still functional, is over ten years old and no longer manufactured or supported with software updates or parts replacement.

This is in support of continued operation and improvement of the Campbell County Sheriff's Office Hazardous Device in service of Campbell County as well as surrounding counties supported by the Rural Emergency Response Team 1.

The Sheriff's Office has historically relied on the receipt of Homeland Security Grants in support of the Hazardous Device Unit equipment in response to our local and national efforts to combat and respond to incidents of foreign and domestic terrorism as well as other incidents involving energetic or suspected hazardous materials. The Sheriff's Office utilizes these funds to purchase specialized equipment that is not allocated for in our normal operating budgets due to the burden the costs would place on Campbell County.

The deadline to submit the grant application to Wyoming Office of Homeland Security is April 3, 2023.
