

# Director's Report

## March 2021

### **Early Intervention:**

- The Wyoming Department of Education program review of Disability Services is continuing. Currently, regional programs are going through interviews with Department of Education staff.
- House Bill 63 did not make it out of the House Education Committee. State funding is still intact as it makes its way through the House and Senate.
- Part C Federal funds are in jeopardy due to Maintenance of Effort (MOE).

### **Early Childhood:**

- Staff are preparing for Week of the Young Child.
- Our fourth dietetic intern from Montana State completed her rotation with us. She has elected to come back for a second rotation during her self-select time. The focus during this rotation will be direct intervention, menus, nutrition curriculum for classrooms, and how and when should families access a dietician.

### **Early Head Start:**

- EHS staff are working on the Grant Application, which is due May 31, 2021.
- Additional COVID-19 funds are available, approximately \$10,000.

### **Financial:**

- Staff are continuing to work on the implementation of the Tyler Accounting System.

### **Personnel:**

- We received a resignation letter from Emily Roberts, her last day is scheduled to be on May 6<sup>th</sup>.

### **Other:**

- We received a donation of school supplies and \$1,720 from St. Mathews Church.

### **Facility:**

- We are working on the new play structure for the west playground. Some challenges with the pour and play have been identified. These challenges may change our initial design.
