Liaison Report – Commissioner Faber reported Commissioner Liaisons have been determined.

Human Resources – Brandy Elder gave staffing update and reported that open enrollment has been finalized.

Road & Bridge – Kevin Geis reported snowplows and sanders have been busy. T-7 road relocations bids will be awarded 1/20/23. Gave update on Bishop Road relocation project. Reported Buckskin mine wants to relocate south end of Collins Road and have offered to pay.

Public Works – Matt Olsen – Reported Barlow Road bridge has been identified as being critical to be replaced by WYDOT. Gave update on Hayden Livestock Road proposal. Gave update on Bishop Road agreement with Campbell County and State of Wyoming for use of county roads to access coal. The current plan is to pave it. Gave update on new Bus Barn location and land transfer. The proposal should be ready to present in February. Reported Pronghorn EDA Grant is currently going through zoning. Gave update on Camporee project – grading is complete for amphitheater. Gave update on Courthouse Annex – during demolition they found an old elevator shaft which required them to change some floorplans.
