FINANCIAL OFFICER'S REPORT:

Rebecca completed purchase orders on time in Tyler, no issues.

CONSUMER HEALTH REPORT:

Doug Evans not present. Report distributed.

HEALTH OFFICER REPORT:

- Dr. Patel reports that this last holiday season consisted of RSV, Influenza, and COVID-19; however, it was not as bad as anticipated. Campbell County has 1 new Tattoo Parlor, which brings the active open to 27.

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING REPORT:

- Nurse Position: Jane reports that two applicants were interviewed; however, one is under contract with her current employer and the other will complete her Bachelor of Science in Nursing in May 2023.
- Financial Specialist/Administrative Assistant Position: Jerrica Sprague accepted the Financial Specialist position and comes to us from the Fire Department. She has been employed with Campbell County for 19 years. Jane reports 4 interviews for the open Administrative Assistant position are scheduled for tomorrow.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Strep testing: Jane reports that strep testing will be begin by appointment only and will be reviewed as needed.
- Prenatal Classes: Jane reports prenatal classes will begin again utilizing Injoy Prenatal, which are evidence programs. The classes will be held here at Public Health. Details and schedule are still being worked on. There will be no fee for the classes.
- High Dose Flu vaccine: Jane reports we ordered and confirmed 40 doses of the high dose flu vaccine for the Senior Center Flu Clinic.

NEW BUSINESS

- House Bill 66: Jane discussed the details of House Bill 66 along with the history of vaccines, vaccine schedules, and vaccine mandates. Dr. Patel discussed federal mandates and guidelines for vaccines.
