The January 20, 2022, Board of Health Meeting was called to order by Chairman Nick Bouzis.

Introductions were made.

Val moved to approve the November 18, 2021, Board of Health minutes, Susie second the motion, motion carried.

**FINANCIAL OFFICER'S REPORT:**

Rebecca completed purchase orders on time, no issues were mentioned by Clerk's office or Commissioners.

**CONSUMER HEALTH REPORT:**

Doug Evans was present. Stephanie, his counterpart was present. Doug presented and reviewed current inspection report.

**HEALTH OFFICER REPORT:**

- Dr. Patel reports, that we have received one of the two emergency approved antiviral medications for COVID-19. Public health has received Molnupiravir, limited doses and the State will only be sending 40 doses every 2<sup>nd</sup> week. Jane and Dr. Patel have been working on a dispensing plan involving providers in the community, getting together an information sheet and consent that will be reviewed by the County Attorney for approval. This plan is in the works and there will be more information as it is available. Omicron is on the rise and the positivity rate is at 50%.

**PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING REPORT:**

- Personnel Changes
  - New Nurse Hired: Jane reports that Haley Idler has started with Public Health and is doing very well thus far.

- Re-advertise for 2nd Nurse: Jane reports that we will re-advertise for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Nurse position in February/March.

### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

- COVID-19 Testing (Jane):
  - Public Health Tests – decrease general public and focus on First Responders (County, City, and State employees) in the community beginning next week. We offer the 20 minute rapid molecular test. Testing available Monday through Friday.
  - Wyo Lab – New lab working with a CLIA Waived lab out of Florida has 4 COVID tests that they offer.
  - Curative Site – Will be leaving in February to another community in need as there are many more testing options here in Gillette.
  - School District – Test to Stay.
- COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics
  - Vaccine Brands: Jane reports we will offer Moderna and Pfizer but will not be getting any Johnson & Johnson. Janes reports that orders are large, and we are able to share with other providers in the community as well as Crook and Weston County.
    - Moderna reviewed:
      - Series
      - Boosters
    - Pfizer reviewed:
      - Series
      - Booster
      - Pediatric
  - CDC Guidance for COVID-19: Jane reviewed the current CDC guidance for COVID-19 positives and exposures.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Antivirals for COVID-19: as reviewed by Dr. Patel.
- County Fair: Jane reports the Wyoming Department of Health has reported that it is not the role of Public Health to provide first aide services at County Fair's. Jane spoke with Brandy regarding this, and they will work with the Fair Board as Public Health transitions out of that role.
- Commissioner's Budget Message: Rusty reviewed the budget message and reports that the assessed eval was higher this year. Rusty reports the Commissioners reviewed the employee surveys and this next fiscal year moving forward will be employee focused.
