The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met with the Fire Board on Wednesday, January 27, 2021 at 5:30 PM.

Present were Rusty Bell, DG Reardon, Bob Maul, Del Shelstad, Colleen Faber, Commissioners; Susan F. Saunders, County Clerk; Carol Seeger, Commissioners Administrative Director, Sean Brown, Deputy County Attorney and members of the Fire Board.

Chief Bender gave an update on the Emergency Fire Suppression Account Program and that he believes it is a good investment.
