Coordinators Teleconference: A big part of the conference call is that Recovery Wyoming presented on their statewide telephone recovery support program and what it can do for CST. A lot of it had to do with the adults and the adult treatment court. The funding panel for JFDC will meet on March 7, 2023, at 9:20AM. Jim has the link and if anyone is interested in being apart of this funding panel. 10 minutes for this meeting is allotted. Jim isn't sure what kind of questions are going to be asked but Jim plans on starting with the Pact Assessment and the research done on this assessment. Jim will bring up 22 people being screened, and 8 participants accepted last year. Jim said that he had to send out the liability paperwork ahead of time. There will be some division changes, CST will now be under Judiciary instead of the Department of Health. Danny Sullivan will be the unit manager with the behavioral health division, Ashley

Provenchio is the new treatment service unit manager, and Alicia Johnson accepted the grant program manager for the new crisis 988 for the state in the behavioral health division. The Judiciary will go into effect in FY25.

MOU between JFDC and Magistrate Hoff: Judge Hoff will give JFDC an invoice and then we will forward it down to Supreme Court.

City 1% Funding: An application has to be submitted for City 1% by March 3, 2023. It was recommended that JFDC apply for more funding. In the application, the funding request was only increased by \$5,000 which could be for quality of life.

Opioid Settlement Funding: The city meeting for the Opioid settlement was on February 6, 2023, and the county met on February 16, 2023. Jim reports that there are a lot of hoops and contingencies in this, and Jim saw that JFDC does not fit in this criteria. Jim asked if Adult Treatment Court has been spoken to yet about this and Administrative Kim brought up the YES House. It was discussed how the participants under Juvenile and Family Drug Court, have problems with marijuana, alcohol, meth, etc., but there haven't been concerns for opioid addiction within our participants.

Training's: There is board training on February 22, 2023, from 5:30PM to 8:00PM and February 23, 2023, from 9:00AM to 11:30AM at the Gillette College, Presentation Hall. The Rocky Mountain Prevention and Traffic Safety Summit will be from May 24, 2023 through May 25, 2023 in Laramie, Wyoming. The coordinators for this must be in Laramie all week long. JR has requested to go to this in which Jim supports this and explained that the JFDC budget has enough money to be able to transfer to cover JR going. NADCP will be in Houston, Texas from June 26, 2023 to June 29, 2023. Jim motions to send Defense Attorney DaNece Day and in speaking with DaNece, she is interested in going on the behalf of the team. Ryan Anderson seconds this motion, and it was approved. It is to be explained to DaNece that if she is not with JFDC for longer than 90 days after this training, then she will be responsible for paying back the amount that JFDC paid to send her. Tall Cop was scheduled for October 1, 2024. CCSD and the Prevention Council will be funding this. Tall Cop will be doing three presentations on this day. The evening one will be geared to school personnel and parents. He will also be doing a community scan.

Budget Update- The budget looks good, the team can see what has been spent and the remaining balance, and the COVID funding has been expended which it needed to be expended by the end of February 2023. We are still doing very, very well.

Other Business- JFDC will be giving a presentation to Elks Lodge #2825 on April 6, 2023. Jim was approached by the Children's Center who would like to create an MOU with JFDC which could be beneficial for an participant who have kids. Judge can look at this and give her thoughts on this. There was also mention of Dolly Parton's book program that sends out a free book a month for children between the ages of 0-5 years old.
