The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met with the Parks and Recreation Board Monday, February 27, 2023 at 4:00 PM.

Present were Colleen Faber, Kelley McCreery, Del Shelstad, Commissioners; Cindy Lovelace, County Clerk; Denton Knapp, Commissioners Executive Director; Kyle Ferris, Deputy County Attorney; and members of the Parks and Recreation Board.

Discussion was held on the options to build a fence between Cam-Plex Park and the Amphitheater being constructed for the Camporee event.

Parks and Recreation Executive Director presented the following items projected to be requested in the FY2023-2024 Budget:

- 2 Additional staff positions to include FT Admin and PT Lifeguard
- Recreation Fitness Floor Replacement
- Bell Knob Sprinkler Head Replacements spread over 3 years
- Softball Complex Feasibility Study
- WPA Building Historical Designation Feasibility Study
- Soup Kitchen building restroom remodel

Parks and Recreation Executive Director reported there is a possibility of a parade in conjunction with Camporee which will be facilitated by the Camporee staff.

Deputy County Attorney reported on the status of the contract between Camporee and the Campbell County Parks and Recreation Department.

Discussion was held about whether the city or the county maintains Martingale Road since it is on county property yet located within the city limits.

No action was taken by the Commissioners, and they left the meeting at 5:03 PM.
