FINANCIAL OFFICER'S REPORT:

- Rebecca completed purchase orders on time in Tyler, no issues.

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING REPORT (Jane Glaser):

- Personnel Changes:
 - a. Nurse Position: Interviewed for position, follow up being done.
 - b. Financial Specialist/Administrative Assistant Position—filled: Jerrica Sprague is our Financial Specialist and Whitney Oster is our Administrative Assistant.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS (Jane Glaser):

- Strep testing: Going well with 2 hours in the AM and 2 hours in the PM. \$5.00 per test and results are given to patient before they leave the office.
- Prenatal Classes: Reba and Joli are utilizing programs from Injoy Prenatal for classes which will begin in April.
- High Dose Flu vaccine: Ordered for this upcoming flu season to be utilized at the Senior Center Flu Clinic in the fall.

- HB 66: House bill 66 did not go anywhere.

NEW BUSINESS (Jane Glaser)

- Official End of COVID-19 Pandemic: The official end date of COVID-19 Pandemic has been declared May 11, 2023. We will continue to test government employees and first responders. The grant goes through June of 2024. Cases have gone down daily and there have been 3 deaths since November of 2022.
- 2023-24 Budget: 2023-24 budget reviewed.
- Guardian Vigilant Exercise: Will be this summer in June and it is a mock plane crash. Public Health will be assisting in triage.
- Partnering with Fire Department to provide Recovery/Respite to fire crew: How we received the mobile unit was explained along with how we utilize it. PHRC working with FIRE so that the unit can be utilized as needed to provide recovery/respice.
- Opioid Settlement Funds: Will be presenting in front of the Commissioners Tuesday.

OTHER BUSINESS (Jane Glaser):

- Mental Health Campaign: Ashley McRae our PMO will be hosting. It is called Man Therapy and Kyle observed that it appears to be statistically supported. Jane reports that the triad for suicides is spontaneous, substance abuse, and lethal means. 21 in 22 of suicides involved a substance. Domestic violence can also be present. Ashley found the program and is looking for funds to help.
- CIT (Critical Incident Training) explained by Jane and how training for Law Enforcement has been successful.
- Jane explained County funded Public Health and that Public Health follows most policies and procedures set by the State.
- Jane reviewed Flu Vaccines and the different clinics Public Health has within Campbell County.

The next Board of Health meeting will be May 18, 2023.
