Chairperson, Trena Bauder called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Trena welcomed everyone to the meeting and invited them to introduce themselves.

**Minutes** ~ Acacia Acord moved to accept the minutes from the April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022, meeting. Marilyn Christensen seconded the motion. Motion passed.

**Reports** ~ Extension Office / 4-H ~ Celeste Hayden reviewed the static exhibit superintendent meeting, County Shoot entries closed May 17<sup>th</sup> including 108 youth and 741 entries. Celeste stated there are 16 members registered for the sewing conference, interns started in the Extension Office, and summer day camp starts on June 6<sup>th</sup>. Kim reported the summer livestock events will start including a fitting and showing clinic, sheep shearing clinic, progress shows, A.I. series, and rodeos. Clover Buds and Young Leaders are concluding their sessions. Kim and Celeste will be at 4-H camp in June and unable to attend the next meeting.

Fair Coordinator ~ Liz Edwards recapped the upcoming Fair entry and tagging deadlines and reviewed the Pig Wrestling entry form process and registration date on June 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm. Liz reported, from the Commissioner's directors meeting, the Camporee event in 2024 is moving forward finalizing a contract and possibly looking at year 2029 for this event again at CAM-PLEX. Liz continued to report the Woolgrowers and Cattlewomen have agreed to invite our local Veterans to the Pioneer Dinner this year.

**Old Business** ~ Ranch Rodeo ~ Trena gave an update with more information on sanctioning the Bronc Riding and not having the mini broncs. Acacia moved to sanction the Bronc Riding for the Ranch Rodeo. Joey seconded the motion. Motion passed. Trena stated the Rodeo committee will meet to discuss options and continued to discuss other options to add another event replacing the mini broncs. Liz commented she has contact information on another mini stock contractor, however, has no details of cost to report.

Social Media ~ Liz asked the Fair Board to review the fair schedule and give her feedback on coordinating social media suggestions. Discussion was held. The Fair Board and Extension Office will help get pictures and video clips of the livestock shows and static exhibits. 
**New Business** ~ Avian Flu update ~ Liz reviewed the current WLSB ruling, and they will be re-evaluated it at the end of May.
