The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met with the Campbell County Public Land Board Thursday, June 10, 2021 at 6:00 PM.

Present were Bob Maul, Del Shelstad, Colleen Faber, Rusty Bell, Commissioners; Carol Seeger, Commissioners Administrative Director and members of the Land Board. Commissioner DG Reardon was present telephonically. Susan F. Saunders, County Clerk and Sean Brown, Deputy County Attorney were absent from the meeting.

The Board discussed the status of the Campbell County Land Board's purchase of the shuttle van as requested in its budget. The City of Gillette did not include the purchase in its proposed budget but has not foreclosed the purchase later in the budget year so the status quo will continue with the Land Board leasing the shuttle van from the Board of Commissioners for a possible purchase later in the budget year as a budget amendment.

Discussion was held on the request by the Land Board to amend its budget request to change the \$340,000 request for electrical upgrades in the Boxelder RV Park to the purchase of portable toilets in anticipation of the Camporee event to be held in 2024. The Land Board said its staff had met with local providers who advised they would not be able to meet the demand but will be servicing the purchased toilets. The \$340,000 will not be enough money to cover all the needed portable toilets but would be a start. Currently, due to fluctuating prices, the purchase price is unknown but is around \$500 per toilet. There still is no plan for storage and Complex staff will be tasked with devising a plan for storage.

Discussion was held on the upcoming proposed fire ban scheduled to be considered on June 15 and consideration of adoption immediately. It was determined that due to notice issues and not having a proposed resolution presently before the Board that staff be directed to put out a public information message advising of the proposed ban and to encourage citizens to exercise extreme caution immediately.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:50 PM.
