Old Business ~ Ranch Rodeo ~ JD and Liz reviewed the Cam-plex set-up and labor requirements for the cow pony race. Liz reported Justin is unable to attend the meeting and will accept the decision of the Fair Board to include or not include the cow pony race. Doug Griffis moved to approve and include the Cow Pony Race with the Ranch Rodeo. There being no second, the motion failed. Dana Trevino asked to consider the cow pony awards towards the mini bull riding. Discussion was held.

Demolition Derby ~ Liz reviewed the set-up changes and/or updates with the Demolition Derby event, adding additional seating due to the increased attendance from previous years.


Fair Veterinarian ~ Liz introduced Dr. Rachel Young and Dr. Emily Violini from Animal Medical Center, who reached out to her offering to be available and help during the Fair week. Dr. Young and Dr. Violini discussed their interest in helping during Fair. Stephanie Styvar moved to table the decision until next month's meeting. Trevor seconded the motion. Discussion was held. Motion passed.

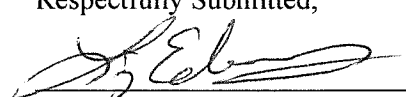

Stephanie moved to accept and approve the donation of a scale indicator for the Central Pavilion scale from Campbell County Farm Bureau, allowing a banner at the scale. Sabrina seconded the motion. Motion passed.
