Chairperson, Trena Bauder called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Trena welcomed everyone to the meeting and invited them to introduce themselves.

**Minutes** ~ Marilyn Christensen moved to accept the minutes from the May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022, meeting. Acacia Acord seconded the motion. Motion passed.

**Reports** ~ Extension Office / 4-H ~ Liz stated Kim Fry and Celeste Hayden are conducting 4-H Camp.

Fair Coordinator ~ Liz Edwards reported the sheep, swine, and goat tagging closed on Wednesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. Liz confirmed shirt sizes and colors for their fair clothing and shared the NHSFR Wyoming night invitation.

**Old Business** ~ Ranch Rodeo ~ Liz reported the rodeo committee met and presented the lineup of events including the teams, match bronc, mutton bustin', and cow pony races. The Match Bronc riding is sanctioned with the Western States Ranch Rodeo Association. The board agreed with the events presented and not to schedule mini-bronc riding for the 2022 Fair. The Board discussed set-up details, supplies, and job assignments.

Avian Flu update ~ Liz stated the WSLB rescinded the Wyoming emergency poultry rule restrictions and allowing local officials to choose how to conduct poultry events/gathering. The WLSB and State Veterinarians will offer HPAI biosecurity information for fairs and exhibitions through a public webinar on Thursday, June 23, 8:30am – 10:30am. Judy Bishop and Lin Riley, the Poultry Superintendents, shared the recommendations gathered from the State Veterinarian regarding our area and show details. Judy and Lin recommend having a day show, check-in the evening before show day, cancel open class poultry, and have the sale projects return the morning of the sale. Acacia moved to cancel the open class poultry show and round robin poultry for the 2022 Fair, due to the avian flu. Trevor seconded the motion. Discussion was held. Motion passed. Marilyn moved to re-schedule the 2022 Poultry Show for one day on Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, check-in on Wednesday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> from 4:00pm – 8:00pm, allow poultry projects to be released after showing, poultry sale animals return on Sunday, August 7<sup>th</sup> morning, and allow parents to assist youth members poultry projects to help limit cross contamination. Acacia seconded the motion. Discussion was held. Motion passed.




**Meeting Adjourned** ~ Trena adjourned the meeting at 7:09pm.
