Directors Workshop

The Campbell County Board of Commissioners met for a Directors Workshop, Tuesday, July 5, 2022, at 1:30 PM.

Matt Olsen provided updates on Bishop Road, the school district and Warlow Drive property, the Camporee event, Pronghorn Industrial Park, Museum crosswalk, Courthouse annex project and the parking garage.

Brandy Elder provided updates on new training for customer service for front line leaders, property insurance audit and renewal, the loss of Coalition use and employees being involved in committees.


Leslie Perkins provided a draft copy of the annual report.


Commissioner Maul moved to convene into executive session to discuss personnel. Commissioner Hamm seconded the motion. All Voted – Aye. Carried.
