Discussion was held concerning the CAM-PLEX Park management during the Camporee 2024.


Discussion was held concerning the options of hiring a consultant to complete a master plan for the Parks and Recreation department.

Discussion held on the water damage and plan to repair the floors in Gym 1, Gym 2, and Gym 3.


Discussion held on the maintenance and usage of the ice arena in Spirit Hall and the option of building a new ice arena.
